- Suggestions: Asian Food more vegan/vegetarian options, introduce other Asian dishes beyond Chinese, offer meal deals that equal the \$8 flexi swipe. Consider different supplier/higher quality meat. Have a signature dish that the Owl Nest is known what is the campus wide pitch?
  - Smoothies Simplify menu by making a base price and then add your choice of three items for X amount, offer Boba, Chai Tea and other Asian drinks Speed up time it takes to get a smoothie order.
  - Crepes reduce offerings only dessert crepes or build your own –choice of 3 items Hours Since the P/K Dining hall is not open weekends, could the café close on Monday/Tuesday and stay open on the weekends? Longer hours on Friday night or even late night service?

**Report Backs – Core Council** - Anna – a meeting has been set for 11/7, she can attend. -**SUGB** – Savanah – Attending intro meeting, introductions and went over Student Union space -**Academic Senate** – Scotty – Only 30 minutes – Grad Division is expanding = more PhD candidates, 16 million short fall in budget but using reserved funds for now. If Prop 30 does not pass, permanent cuts coming and up to 20% tuition hike for winter. Prop failure will trigger a \$375. million system wide cut = 8 million to each of our 4 campus units.

-SUA - Lyle - The Comm. of Acad. Affairs – Shiku is writing a renewal referendum for Library funding – the current one is due to expire. Also working on extending the Arc Ctr. hours, Discussed USSA – (United States Student Association) all students are automatically members through reg. fees. It is important to get involved-activism for students including legislation, leadership opportunities, internships, student financial aid including loan payment.
