## Committee Report Backs

Academic Senate: Anna - Education Forum held on April $26^{\text {th }}$ in Stevenson Event Center. On-line education as a supplement not substitute was discussed with numerous prestigious guest speakers \& VC Alison Galloway. Panel discussed pros/cons and how a budget would need to be found to allow access at no/low cost. Making education available to more people around the world.

Core Council: Anna - They have funded 9 groups. $\$ 1072.84$ to BMA Dance/must recycle H2O bottles, $\$ 200$ to ISO event(Indian student org.), $\$ 600$ to KASA (Korean students), $\$ 2000$ for CJP Palestinian awareness week, $\$ 218$ to SFPD (Prof. Develop event) $\$ 1800$ JSA (Persian Shabbat) $\$ 300$ to Japanese Student Organization, $\$ 2000$ to MSA Muslim Awareness Week, $\$ 3205$. To Relay for Life Cancer fundraiser Funding in total $\$ 14,833.84$. and they have $\$ 8000$ left for carry forward. One more request coming from our Jewish Fraternity for a Car smash event. Requesting $\$ 3000$. for expenses but not organized with no location, advertising, event approvals. It is to raise $\$$ for Save a Childs Heart Org. Students would pay to hit the vehicle drained of fluids at Quarry Plaza(?) Parliament is not in support of funding this event as it stands. Next meeting they will discuss the future or Core Council for next year.

SUA: Lyle, Carl, Kelsey - Presentation on 2012 national elections campaign. A lot of statistics with social media playing a huge role. Campus wide we tabled during welcome week \& flyered urging students to register to vote. We need more communication/volunteers to increase visibility. Retrofit has been delayed for SUA bldg. to the year after next - still working on move plan. The External Vice Chair requested approval to spend $\$ 2700$ of his budget for event. Focus would be on student struggles: art expo, food, shirts, $\$ 150-\$ 200$ in prizes. (He did not spend this money on an intern this year) The SUA budget plan for next year is looking good. Same changes; typos, General Fund will be separate line item, $3 \%$ for employee benefits. Each office will get funding for their office and Chaz asking for more \$ for IVC Office because of the number of events. $10 \%$ of carry forward gets split: 70\% General Fund/30\% SUA Programming.
