-Renewed Partnership with NASA, The Budget of the UC is being cut by 115 mil.- 13 mil will come out of UCSC after increased fees of $8.5 \%$ by the governor. By July $1^{\text {st }} 3.8 \%-5.3 \%$ of cuts academic -Academic Grievance- was 1 year now cut to 6 months
-New GEs, more applicable and respectful to CA's diversity.
-College Affordability Act- AB462- senate bill that will freeze fees up to 5 years, taxing those who income is 1 mil by $1 \%$ for every mil.
