- Constitutional amendment proposed for this years election ballot - removing voting rights of the Big 5 orgs (ABSA, APISA, MECHA, ESOC, SINAI) and The Network among other changes – still needs to get on the ballot.
- Measure 40 → Increase in reg. fees for OPERS. to extend OPERS hours and services
 - NO because we have no way to see how the money is allocated and if it's being allocated to extending hours.
- Measure 38 → Reallocate funds and other sources directly to UCSC instead of out of state companies on sustainability
- Measure 39 → Increase in reg. fees for the Sustainability Office projects and staff
- Muslim Student Association got fully funded \$500.
- Future Health Care Professionals – Bio end of year celebration - budget request- tabled
- \$2000 funded for Colleges Against Cancer event – 24 hour Relay for Life – May 23 & 24
