Construction updates:

- \*Porter/Kresge Dining Hall programming space will open in January 2010
- \*Will make announcement, if dining hall will not open (due to budget cuts) in 2-3 weeks.
- \*\$250,000 (money for operational costs and utilities) saved by not opening dining hall this year or staff lay offs might be required. Suggestion made to close an East side Hall instead of only having one West side location.
- \*Tuesday, Mike attended Senate meeting with Porter, trying to open the dining hall.
- \*An additional \$1.5 million for business services on campus was added to college budgets
- \*New building at Porter is using 30% less energy. B-dorm exterior will be done by Oct 23.
- \* Town hall subs will probably be shutting down because Hungry slug location will open in January.

  New management to be announced flexi-dollars only (not meal equivalencies).
- \* Town Hall will be used for programming and class space for rest of year.
- \* Heavy A-building construction starts next week. Adding two floors. Footprint for A-building is smaller than B-building. Hopefully will be done on time for fall move-in in September.

- \*150% raise in student fees over recent years. Tuition \$600 more than last year.
- \*UC Regents is purposing students affiliated with Business/Engineering pay additional 'fees"
- \*Mid-year and then tuition hikes for next year 32% increase in total
- \*Cal Grant- \$50,000 budget cut. Affects 7,000 out of 16,000 students in UCSC.
- \* 6% cut in enrollment at UC's due to budget deficit
