Students, Community members met at the Quarry Plaza on Wednesday, Nov. 18, at 12PM. Marched down Hagar and blocked the entrance of UCSC also blocking the west entrance. 32% Tuition hike was passed – significant graffiti was found at College Eight and Porter Activists marched up the west side and occupied the Kresge Town Hall. Some students traveled by bus to UCLA to protest the Regents meeting. Thursday, the 2nd floor of Kerr Hall was occupied, staff had to leave the building Students spoke with David Klieger, Executive Vice Chancellor – turned in a list of demands Students also remain in the Kresge Town Hall – per invitation by Provost Poblete UCSA will be organizing a state wide march on Sacramento - March 31st
