Budget Requests:

UCSC Mock Trial: A student program which represents the university as a whole. There are no current Kresge members. They went to regional competition and advanced to opening round of championship series. They need to pay for the travel expenses; registration fees, hotel, gas. asking other college senates and money from Cowell Provost, SUA. Their total budget is \$1,555. Requesting \$400.

UCSC Model United Nations: Jerry - A club that takes students to other schools and debates topics of international conflict/historical events. Trip to San Francisco for the M.U.N. event March 3-6 sponsored by Berkeley with 26 colleges. Requesting \$100 for travel expenses. M.U.N. emphasizes power and representation. teaching a class at college ten, has around 25-30 members, including a Kresge student. It is a campus wide club. 15 students will be attending the conference.

Transformative Action/One University Together: Requesting \$200 to help fund the free education event on March 2nd at OPERS.
