Report Backs: SUA - Justin

Icebreakers and introductions of committees. They decided to alternate between general meetings and committee meetings weekly. Justin wrote a proposed resolution that calls for a new Student Union facility - to be presented to SUA, approved by Parliament.

Committees RSO- Registered Student Organizations: Treasurer is not elected yet, but must sit on this committee. Purpose of RSO is to hear budget requests and funds. Not in bylaws yet. Student Power: A committee that is supposed to organize students around both on/off campus issues (such as Academic Students disqualifying students for majors, student fees, organizing students in Sacramento). Student Power Chair is proposing to take members to

Salinas/Watsonville to educate undocumented workers about ICE (Immigration Customs Enforcement) Opinion of our representative: this is not in the best interests of UCSC resources. Outreach & Student Life- Purpose of this committee is to reach out to students and to improve student life on campus. Internal Vice Chair of this committee proposes education on student fees, on race issues, on organizing with labor unions.

<u>Lobby Core-</u> Purpose of this organization is to lobby for student's interests in various places (regents, Sacramento, Washington D.C). SUA rep asked if lobby was on the Feds continuing budget resolutions, which opens up a chance for funding to be cut every 5 weeks – yes it is!

<u>Student Academic Senate-</u> body where students who sit on committees can discuss official stances on issues and speak with others about Academic Senate related issues.

<u>Commissioner of Diversity-</u> (DT presented on Diversity Commission) Will to work with on-campus ethnic orgs and cover administrative details. Applications deadline is Friday 11/7/11
