SUA-Lyle- Confusing start to meeting - FSA Family Student Housing Co-Op Resolution has been discussed, approval next week. Emergency Constitutional Amendment approved last week. Language for spring ballot Constitutional Amendment being approved for the future. Two board members for United States Student Association need an additional \$4,000 allocated for expenses to represent UC Santa Cruz. Board Members are requesting an additional \$1500. - \$2000 for travel expenses for Leg Con and Colorado Board meeting.
