**Budget Requests:** APISA - Asian Pacific Island Student Alliance: May is their heritage month and the Resource Center is planning events for the whole month. Educational forum includes a youth educator who is an ex con and Illegal immigrant, Inprisoned at 16, he now spreads awareness about the prison complex industry as well as racism and imperialism that still exists today. Eye opening even for alliance members. Requesting funding from other colleges for \$9280. budget, AAPIRC + \$2000 and Equity Office + \$5000. Requesting \$500. Free event open to all - May 15, 7-9 pm Multipurpose Room College 9/10.

El Centro Chicano Resource Center: 11th Annual Cesar Chavez Convocation – Intern, Ruby(Kresge) Event is Tuesday May 20th 6:30-9pm with post reception in Multipurpose Room at Colleges 9/10.
