Core Class Presentation 10/21/14 – Went well – longer than 5 minutes though.

SFAC – Carl –Intense meeting about Quarry Amphitheater renovation. Cost of Phase I is 7.388 million. Suggested funding; 2 million = Seismic Fee money, \$1.5 mil = Student Fees with an aim to fundraise 4 million dollars. If Phase 1 is approved it includes a new ADA entry, seats, paved & stabilized roadway, lighting, signage and WiFi. Maintenance will cost about \$40,000 per year more if Phase II is approved. Phase II would add a smart stage; power, infrastructure, lawn seating, concession stand, a support building with kitchen, restrooms and an ADA elevator. Students will get priority using the amphitheater and it is believed that rentals will help pay for Phase II? Issues are parking and maintenance, still being discussed. SFAC also overseeing upgrades to UCSC: Phase A going on now = telecommunication upgrades on the West side, 10-100 times faster Internet, Phase B: Student Health, Phase C: Student Life Facilities like the Redwood Bldg.
