Budget Requests for next week: Colleges Against Cancer - Relay for Life fundraiser. Relay event will be April 29-30 10 a.m. – 10 a.m. on the East Field. Planning for 200 participants. This event supports those who have been impacted by cancer. Participants can talk about their personal experiences and celebrate fighters and survivors. Expenses include rental of the east field, security, porta potties, entertainment and tech support. Asking all colleges for funding. Requesting \$200, of \$3780. total budget. Carl motioned to invite. Tara 2nds, 13 Hoots = Approved.

Camp Kesem – A national nonprofit organization that supports children with a parent(s) with cancer. They provide a weeklong summer camp Aug. 8-11 at Redwood Glen Camp. Ninety students attend and members gain experience working with the non-profit. They are OPERS affiliated. Requesting \$500 of their \$105,000 budget. Asking all colleges for support \$200. - \$500. level. Parliament discussed this request and had concerns over participation and/or benefit for the Kresge Community. Carl motioned to not invite, Celinda 2nd. 7 Hoots, 6 Abstain = Approved.

Kresge Carry Forward Account Request - Pam

-Kresge's Program Office laptop is 10 years old. Requesting \$1600(+/-) for purchase of new Dell laptop. Carl suggests we look at other vendors and military grade housing in case it is dropped. Hana motions to approve the purchase, Tara 2nds; 13 Hoots = Approved.

-The CPC's are collaborating on a campus wide storytelling event on April 13-14. We are bringing an interactive, award winning project, Dear World, to campus. Dear World asks the question, "If you had one story to share with the world, what would you say?" Through photo shoots and story sessions, they facilitate this 2-day program open to students, staff and faculty. The goal is to share and illuminate the diversity of the UCSC Community. All colleges are being asked to help fund this event with \$500 - \$1000. The total budget is \$14,000. Including Dear World = \$13,000., facility rentals = \$550., Tech = \$180. and advertising = \$235. Parliament discussed this two day event and had concerns about it being on the east side of campus, primarily on a Friday, not student driven, being 1 snap shot in time and the over all expense to bring Dear World here from out of the area. Carl motioned to not fund with carry forward money, Michelle 2nds; 6 Hoots, 8 Abstain = Approved.

A 2-day program where they make a video of everyone's stories. They are also asking for money from all of the colleges \$500-1000. Also soliciting off campus contributions, Provosts, Chancellor and so on. Presented by Cowell Senate. Approved Sexual Assault system wide resolution, Jessica Xu. was approved as the new VP Academic Affairs.

SFAC-Sylvia- Finished grading 50 funding proposals, will meet Friday to review. Our campus has a new CP/EVC replacing Alison Galloway, New collegiate funding program to help support UCSC Athletics. This measure would be up for vote in the spring asking students to pay \$45. per quarter. Another measure will ask students to increase funding for SUA from \$7 to \$20. per quarter. (Unclear of funding would be shared with colleges?) Undocumented Student Emergency Fund – adding a fee to help with ongoing expenses needed under changing policies of our Federal Administration. Parliament is not in support of funding Athletics, needs clarification on the SUA increase and is in support of an emergency fund.
