**Funding Request:** Francisco - 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Campus Cleanup Sat. May 6<sup>th</sup> 10 – 1 p.m. – Goal is to increase awareness of liter on campus + waste responsibility. 256 pounds of litter were collected last year with 150 volunteers. They are expecting 200+ volunteers this year. Started outreach earlier. Advertising with flyers and tabling. Requesting \$200 of their \$1260. budget. Expenses include color and B+W tees, breakfast food and supplies for trash pick up. Asking all colleges. Event will start with breakfast, small groups, cleaning, regrouping and weighing collected trash.

**New Budget Requests:** UCSC Dear World portrait project - April 13<sup>th</sup>/14th. Requesting \$200. to help with the budget of \$14,600. Event will be open to all and share stories through photo portraits. Each participant will write a message on their body for the photo. Final event Friday night at MPR will share stories and photos. Expenses include Dear World project facilitators \$13,000. facility rental and tech, refreshments and supplies. Asking each college government and SUA for support. Advertising with flyers, posters and emails. Parliament believes this is not unique, just a cookie cutter project that won't benefit Kresge College. Carl motions to not invite, Tara 2nds: 7 Hoots, 5 Abstain = Approved.

Rachel Carson College Earth Week – Numerous events April 17-22 under the theme "Taking action in our environment". They are requesting \$200. Total budget is \$4550 for all the events including presenters, activities and education. Celinda motions to invite, Hana 2nds: 10 Hoots, 2 Abstain = Approved.

**Deliberations:** Budget update from Toan = \$334.00/winter quarter Campus-wide Cleanup event is important and organized. Kresge Parliament is not in favor of funding tee shirts but can fund cleaning supplies. Hana motions to fund \$150. Carl 2nds: 8 Hoots, 4 Abstain = approved.

**Parliament Business:** The African Student Union responded to our request for their budget for their Culture Show May 11<sup>th</sup> 8-10 p.m. in Stevenson Event Center – Budget includes Rainbow theatre, costumes, decorations, food, flyers, and tech. They requested \$400. Parliament agrees this is a worthy event, open to all. Ian motions to fund \$150, Jos 2nds: 9 Hoots, 4 Abstain = Approved.

**Approval of minutes: 3.2.17** Correction for announcements – UCSC equestrian competed on Saturday not Sunday. Tara motions to approve with correction, Ian 2nds: 10 Hoots, 1 Screech, 2 Abstain = Approved.

**Outreach:** Our winter community service project was last Saturday, Kresge Blues Concert in the Town Hall with the Lucille Blues Band. With Franklin Williams Service Learning students and the VSA, we raised \$120. to donate to local homeless support. Donated food was great addition, wish more attended but those who did come enjoyed the music. Thank you to everyone who worked the event!

**New Business:** Spring Community Service Project ideas: - Got socks fundraiser, elementary school clean up, St. Francis Soup Kitchen service, Beach Clean-up = TBD

CAO meeting – Sawyer has set up a meeting with Mike Yamauchi-Gleason tomorrow, Friday at 1:30 p.m. Quinn and Max and Sawyer will be attending in the J building tomorrow. Ian will also attend to discuss housing issues here at Kresge proper.

Seminar Room 159 improvements. Pam researched chair options, worried that foldable chairs could be a safety concern. Shared a padded, stackable chair option that is \$29.99 and comes in numerous colors. 40 chairs plus shipping would be \$1500. We will suggest getting 4 different colors, 10 each. Pam will share info with Common Ground/David Shaw and we will need to fine-tune the amount they can contribute.

Kresge Free Library – promotion moving forward now that it is dedicated and open for use. Michelle made 5 flyer options to use = correct title and contact email for Parliament. Sawyer put a yellow star burst on the Parliament meeting sandwich board on Upper St. Sawyer will ask Mike if we can send a college wide

email? Add to Kresge web site under activities sponsored by Parliament. Carl and Sylvia could email Departments, Have another event connected to national "something" day? Add to end of year Housing email for move out. (Check laminate cost for large poster at bin location.)

We need 1 SUA Rep. for spring weekly Tuesday meetings, Tara has a class conflict and must step down. Nominations for a vote next week: Hana nominates Ian. Tara nominates Quinn. (Tara will bring in the Kresge College SUA name plates)

**Report Backs:** SUA – Tara, Hana, Ian - Food for finals coming next week outside McHenry Library, instead of food they will have testing supplies Tuesday 2-4 p.m. On Wednesday 3-5 p.m. outside of SE Library they will have food. Sr. Trivia Night tomorrow 6 p.m. 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of Bookstore bldg. Hispanic Servicing Institution presentation (schools with 33% or more Hispanic students like UCSC) Nadine was terminated from the Math department, they are working on replacing course options with on-line classes. Measure 8 SUA programs fee presentation: \$7 to \$20 per quarter to help fund SUA advisor raise, food pantry that will be located off campus after 5 years, legacy projects, raising stipends for SUA officers. External Affairs is taking a trip to DC for Lobby Core, they have an organized work, not play, plan. ISA presented about Holi Fest. being held Friday, April 14<sup>th</sup>, they spend \$6400. for the colored powder. Basic student rights were included in a letter to the Chancellor, hoping to help with retention with student demands for study space, lounges, guarantees for themed housing and a response from Chancellor on these issues. The 3<sup>rd</sup> annual campus clean up was funded, SUA Constitutional amendment was supported.

SCOC – Quinn – Sister college event this weekend, RCC/Oakes holding a Carnival on Saturday, March 11th 4-8pm. DJ, games, food for all. C4 highlights = would like to split up CORE class removing the writing requirement to focus on college community. CS major impacted looking at on-line classes. Issues with "W" for classes, not fair to other students. More diverse faculty, evaluation bias, Annual faculty salary increases need to be explained, Sanctuary status not complete for UCSC and more internships needed that don't require a social security number.

Core Council – Danny – Reviewed 4 more proposals.

SFAC - Sylvia – no update, still going over proposals

SUGB – Danny – How to split reserve funds between OPERS and SUGB. Would like 60/40 split. SUGB uses their money to fund programs and maintain the Student Union building at Quarry Plaza. Hana motions to approve the split, Toan 2nds. 12 Hoots = Approved. Tomorrow, Study Jam - free test supplies and food at Quarry Plaza from 2-5 p.m.
