Asking all colleges and SUA. Advertising with emails and flyers to come. Requesting \$300. Hoping 70 people will attend.

PRISM - Theta Pi Sigma - Queer Prom May 12<sup>th</sup> 8-12 a.m. in the Kresge Town Hall - an event for queer and trans students who might not had this experience from high school.
