**Funding Requests:** Colleges Against Cancer: Annual Relay for Life – May 12<sup>th</sup> 10 a.m. – 10 p.m. East Field. Requesting \$200. Of 3,340.25 budget. Cancer changes the lives of 1.5 million people so raising money for American Cancer Society. Education and support with teams sponsored to walk continuously. Event is for anyone affected by cancer and will include a luminary ceremony at dark including guest speakers/cancer survivors. Budget includes rental, supplies, equipment, recycling, food, lights. TAPS requesting endorsement for Measure 24 on spring ballot - would be happy to come back to Parliament to answer questions. Proposed Fee Referendum with 20-year sunset clause and graduated fee increases starting fall quarter through 2021. Students currently pay \$111.66 each quarter. Response needed by March 23<sup>rd</sup>. Without increase support, services will be cut; Compounded bus will be gone; Night Owls will be gone. TAPS also presented to SFAC.
