Budget Requests:

Red Wheelbarrow – Student run lit. magazine requesting \$200. for printing costs. Printed annually in the spring, includes prose, poetry and art. Increasing to 1000 copies with 120+ pages. Asking all colleges and distributed campus wide. \$5,529.70 total budget. Submission deadline is today.

SlugMUN III – “MUN stands for “Model UN.” Requesting \$100 for collegiate conference/debate on contemporary issues. Model is United Nations, think political D&D. 20-30 UCSC students expected to participate of 70+ total. Invitation only for May 3-5 event in Baskin Engineering. Total budget is \$2281. including supplies, facility rental and snacks. Asking all colleges, 14% of members are Kresgians. Financial supporters will be recognized in packets and electronically.

Team leaders will take teams out between 10 – 2 p.m. Benefits include 2020 Zero waste goal awareness, beautify campus and create community bonds. Danny motions to not invite, motions dies. UCSC Bone Marrow Drive. April 12th, 9/10 Multipurpose Room from 10:30 – 4:30 p.m. Raises awareness of need for bone marrow donations, registers potential donors via swab. Asking all colleges and tabling campus wide. Expenses include postcards, mascot rental and banners. Re \$1000 budget, request \$100. Quinn motions to fully fund, Anna 2^{nds}, 10 Hoots = Approved.

Ten Colleges Debate Union – Off campus event Feb. 22 – 24. Requesting \$400. of \$1475. Budget for fees, gas, and judges. Also inviting community colleges to practice debate skills. UCSC sending 12 students. Due to event date, Parliament cannot hear their request in time to support. Owen motions to not invite, Ian 2^{nds}, 9 Hoots, 2 Abstain = Approved

EyeCandy Journal – Requesting \$150. of \$5056. budget for printing their annual journal. Includes film & media journalism. Printed late May and distributed widely across campus. Staff included Kresgians. Asking all colleges, Core Council and Provost Project Funds. Owen motions to invite, Karlee 2^{nds}, 7 Hoots, 1 Screech, 3 Abstain = Approved
