### **Guests:** Career Center – Spring Referendum Measure

Career Center seeking sponsorship to get on ballot for funding referendum for a new +\$10.89/quarter fee. Technology: \$2.31, Programming: \$4.99, Return-to-aid: \$3.59, with 12 yr. sunset. Money would go towards upgrading facilities, tech, increased operating hours and more internships/job skills. Employers don't/can't pay to go to campus, would include nonprofits. Career Center needs to get bigger: 5 career coaches for 19k students. Currently, 3,500 students have one-on-ones. 8-5 pm office hours is less than accessible for some. Career Center is a Hispanic-serving institution also many other diverse populations. Previous referendum was 2.5x more expensive = failed to obtain the required votes. Student Success funded some positions. Referendum helps improve technology/platforms.
